ANNUAL REPORT

During the academic year 2024–25, the English Department recorded a total enrolment of **524 students**, reflecting its sustained academic engagement across multiple disciplines. This cohort comprised 120 students in First-Year Arts, 240 in First-Year Commerce, 59 in Second-Year Arts, 42 in First-Year Science, 31 in Second-Year Science, and 32 in Third-Year Arts.

In alignment with the NEP 2020 university guidelines, the department adopted a structured internal evaluation framework that included mid-semester examinations and assignments. For FYBCOM, FYBA, FYBSC, and SYBSC, the internal assessment carried 15 marks, with 10 marks assigned to examinations and 5 marks to assignments. For SYBA and TYBA, the internal assessment total of 30 marks, following the same distribution of 20 marks for internal examinations and 10 marks for assignments, while the remaining marks were awarded based on additional evaluative components. To further enhance students' academic preparedness, practice tests were administered to assess proficiency and reinforce learning.

As part of its commitment to linguistic and cultural enrichment, the department actively participated in the observance of Marathi Language Day on 27 February 2025, encouraging students to engage with regional language and heritage. Additionally, supplementary lectures were conducted to assist students in exam preparation and to address any academic difficulties they encountered.

The English Department remains steadfast in its mission to support the academic growth and overall development of its students, continually striving to cultivate their skills and promote excellence in learning.
