

VENOMOUS Snake's

BUNGARUS - KRAIT

Phylum - Chordata

Group - Vertebrata

SubPhylum - Gnathostomata

Class - Reptilia

Genus - Bungarus

IDENTIFICATION CHARACTER

- Bungarus is commonly called Krait
- Body is Elongated
- Colour is Steel blue with narrow cross
- Eyes are Moderate size with narrow pupil
- Bungarus is venomous and its Venom is Neurotoxic



INDIAN COBRA-

Naja naja

Phylum - Chordata

Group - Vertebrata

Class - Reptilia

Genus - Naja

Species - naja

IDENTIFICATION CHARACTER

- Naja Naja Commonly called Indian Cobra
- Body is Elongated 2 mtrs long
- Body is covered with smooth oblique scales
- Body colors black brown
- The expansion of neck and cervical ribs form hood
- Cobra is deadly poisonous and It's venom is Neurotoxic



Viper – Viper russelli


Class – Reptilia

Species - russelli

IDENTIFICATION CHARACTER

- Viper is Commonly called Russell's
- Body is Elongated and measured up To one And half meter
- Colour is pale brown above with three longitudinal series of black Spot with underpart with yellowish white
- The scales are about 30 rows On the Body
- Eyes are golden iris Elliptical Pupil
- Viviparous
- Very poisonous venom is Hemotoxic





Non-venomous Snake's

Rat snake - Zamenis

Phylum - Chordata

Group - Vertebrata

SubPhylum - Gnathostomata

Class - Reptilia

Genus - Zamenis

Species - mucosus

IDENTIFICATION CHARACTER

- Zamenis mucosus is called dhaman
- Length is more than 2 meters
- It is brown above Often with black bands on posterior part Of Body and tail underpart is yellowish
- The scales on the Body Form 16 17 rows
- Oviparous
- Non-poisonous (Fangs Absent)

IDENTIFICATION CHARACTER

- Python molurus commonly called Indian Python or aagar
- It is large Massive non poisonous snake
- Length 10 mtrs Indian thickest and longest snake
- It's weight is 125kg & Colour is brown Above with Thomboid dark Gray edged spot on Body Ventral side is greyish with yellow Brown spot
- Scales are 60 70 rows, Eyes are Without eyelids
- Head is distinct from neck Tail is short and Prehensile
- Oviparous, feed on birds mammals
